



## **GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS FOR AJHA PROVINCIAL SHOW 2021**

1. The AJHA Provincial Show is open to all Junior Hereford members who have **paid** their annual activity fee. As well, the show is open to Juniors showing all other breeds however, must be CJHA members. Please see [http://www.hereford.ca/2\\_member/membership/CJHA\\_Membership\\_Application\\_2012.pdf](http://www.hereford.ca/2_member/membership/CJHA_Membership_Application_2012.pdf). Please note all other breeds will compete in open classes.
2. There is a \$40 participant fee to be paid at time of entry. Cattle entry fee is \$25/head. Cow/calf entries are considered one entry. All entry fees must accompany the entry forms and the cheques made payable to AJHA. There is no fee for showmanship. When animals are entered in both the open show and bred & owned class, they will only pay one entry fee.
3. This is a family event. The objective is to work together as a family and help your children when necessary. **WE STRONGLY ENCOURAGE** only the juniors doing the grooming/fitting of their animals. If they need help, help them, but we discourage adults doing everything for them. This event is a learning opportunity for youth.
4. Show is open to ages 22 & under as of January 1, 2021.
  - Pee Wee – 8 years old & under
  - Junior – 9-12 years old
  - Intermediate – 13-16 years old
  - Senior – 17-22 years old
5. All purebred animals entered must have a photocopy of the original registration certificate. Purebred Herefords must be registered in Canada with the Canadian Hereford Association. All animals including calves must be legibly tattooed and have RFID tags in place. Animals that do not fulfill these requirements will be disqualified. All animals must be broke to lead. All yearling and two-year old bulls must be shown with a nose ring.
6. Commercial cattle must be of strong Hereford influence or may enter in the All Other Breeds Open Show. This will be left to the discretion of the AJHA show committee.
7. Juniors without animals may participate in all competitions except the bred and owned, in which the exhibitor must be both the breeder and owner of the animal.
8. An animal entered in the semen donation class must be bred by the exhibitor, be sired by a bull whose semen was awarded through the CJHA's Semen Donation Program and be out of the dam which was nominated for the program by the member himself/herself.
9. Tampering with cattle is strictly prohibited.
10. All animals must be free of any transmittable or zoonotic disease.
11. The AJHA and/or its members are not responsible for accidents or losses that may occur. All juniors attending do so at their own risk.
12. Once cattle are stalled, they are not permitted to leave the show grounds until release time.
13. The AJHA committee reserves the right to determine eligibility of all entries if requirements are not met.

**New Competitions** – entry will be indicated at registration desk

1. Heifer Bracket: Exhibitors may enter yearling heifers born in 2020 into a heifer bracket. Heifers will face off in pairs and face sequential elimination until a winner is determined.
2. Family Team Grooming: Teams of three consisting of at least one junior with either other junior members or adults will compete. The teams will be given a time limit, given at the event, in which they must prepare one animal for the showing.
